



Code of Conduct & general information (during Covid-19) Fawn Lake Resort

Please read the information below carefully and put your initials in the box next to each section - even if they don't apply for your stay. Your initials reflect that you and your party understand and agree to obey the statements.

Before arriving at Fawn Lake Resort

- ✓ Anyone who has had symptoms of Covid-19 in the last 10 days before arrival is prohibited from Fawn Lake Resort. (Symptoms include fever, chills, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, and new muscle aches or headache)
- ✓ Anyone directed by Public Health to self-isolate is prohibited from Fawn Lake Resort.
- ✓ Anyone who has arrived from outside of Canada or who has had contact with a confirmed Covid-19 case must self-isolate for 14 days before coming to Fawn Lake Resort.
- ✓ Guests bring their own hand sanitizer, disposable gloves and other protective equipment.
- ✓ Guests fill out, initial and sign the Code of Conduct and submit it back to Fawn Lake Resort

Check-in & check-out

- ✓ Check-in for cabins after 3pm & for camping after 2pm
- ✓ Check-out before 10am
- ✓ Upon arrival stop at the office to check-in. Please use doorbell.
- ✓ If you wish a contact free check-in/-out, please let us know. Your final invoice will then be e-mailed to you for payment via E-transfer or by cheque.

General

- ✓ Social distancing of at least 2 metres (6 feet) of all guests except those of the same household.
- ✓ Parents must ensure that their children maintain a 2-metre (6 feet) separation from other children/people from other parties at all times during your stay.
- ✓ Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with warm water and soap every time you enter or exit your unit.
- ✓ Only booked guests are allowed on Fawn Lake Resort property. No visitors, please.
- ✓ Shared washrooms & showers are exclusively reserved for renters of the classic cabins #1 - #3 and the cedar cabin. Camping guests must use their RV's facilities.
- ✓ Laundry facility will be available upon reservation (sign in sheet at office door) for one party at a time. After every user, laundry will be cleaned by Fawn Lake Resort staff.
- ✓ Rec-room remains closed, trampoline is not available, playground open at your own risk.
- ✓ Communal freezer in the fish cleaning station is exclusively reserved for renters of the classic cabins #1 - #3, the guest suite and the cedar cabin.



- ✓ All guests are responsible for placing their own garbage into resort garbage bins. Garbage bins in front of cabins will not be available.
- ✓ Refundable bottles and cans can be placed in recycling bins next to the shower house. Other recycling options (cardboard, paper, tins etc.) are not available.

Group

- ✓ Each group in an RV site or a cabin must be from the same household.
- ✓ Households are defined as those people that live in one home.
- ✓ Maximum group size per campsite: 6 guests including minors.
- ✓ Maximum group size in cabins #1 - #5: 4 guests; cabin #6: 6 guests; small cedar cabin & guest suite: 2 guests

Cabin information

- ✓ Keys to your cabin will be on the dining table
- ✓ The following kitchen items are available: BBQ, appliances incl. microwave, pans, tea towels, cloth, dishwashing liquid
- ✓ Bedding: mattress protector & fitted sheet provided
- ✓ Bathroom: towels, hairdryer, soap, toilet paper provided
- ✓ Please bring your own: kitchen utensils, cutlery, plates, drink glasses, bedding & pillow.
- ✓ Upon departure please leave windows and doors open to allow for fresh air circulation, cabin keys can be left on the dining table

Camping information

- ✓ Any RV guests must be self-sufficient with water & bathroom facilities in their unit.
- ✓ Picnic table & fire pit available and will be cleaned by Fawn Lake staff after departure of each guest
- ✓ Please bring your own tablecloth for picnic table
- ✓ Sani station is open, honey wagon is available for guest use only (Please bring your own gloves)
- ✓ Tenting on serviced sites only. Designated outhouse stall will be assigned to each site. No showers available.

Boating information

- ✓ Electric motorboats, kayaks, canoes and SUPs are available for rent but must be reserved ahead of time to allow for thorough cleaning
- ✓ Rental boat batteries will only be handled by Fawn Lake Resort staff
- ✓ Life vests will be cleaned and hung up to dry for 3 full days after use. Guests keep their life vest for the whole duration of their boat rental.

Front office & store

- ✓ Store/office hours are: 8 – 10.30am, 2.30 – 6pm
- ✓ Firewood can be purchased and will be delivered by Fawn Lake staff
- ✓ Ice cubes & blocks, sweets, beverages, fishing tackle, souvenirs etc. can be purchased at the store. Only 1 guest at a time in the store, please.



- ✓ BC Angling Licences can be purchased (if possible, let us know ahead of time and send your personal information by e-mail)
- ✓ All purchases will be added to your tab. Payment options: Debit card (preferred), credit card, cheque & cash. If you wish to pay online and have your final invoice sent by e-mail at the end of your stay, let us know.
- ✓ If you need anything from town (Lone Butte, Interlakes, 100 Mile House) but don't want to leave the resort, let us know and we will add it to our grocery shopping tour.

In case you get sick

- ✓ Sick guests should report to the 100 Mile House Hospital, even with mild symptoms.
- ✓ A guest with confirmed Covid-19 must inform the resort management (250 593 4654) immediately and cannot re-enter the resort property.

- ✓ Fawn Lake Resort management monitors COVID-19 risks and developments closely. Changes to our policies and procedures are implemented as necessary.
- ✓ All safety measures are based on provincial health & work safety recommendations.

Last, but not least

- ✓ Please be kind and supportive – Remember, we are all in this together!
- ✓ If you come across someone not maintaining social distancing requirements, remember that they may be in the same household group. If someone infringes in your 2 metres distance, kindly remind them of the social distancing rule. Please de-escalate any confrontational situations and if needed report the situation to the office.
